NEW LEGAL DOCUMENT

THERE WILL BE FREE HPV VACCINE AND SEASONAL FLU VACCINE

On August 15, 2022, the Government issued Resolution No. 104/NQ-CP, which will increase the number of vaccines in the Expanded Immunization Program for the 2021-2030 period.

Accordingly, the Government has agreed to increase the number of vaccines in the Expanded Immunization Program for the period 2021 - 2030 as follows:

- Vaccines against rotavirus disease from 2022, vaccine against pneumococcal disease from 2025, vaccine against cervical cancer (mainly caused by HPV virus, commonly known as HPV vaccine) from 2026 and a seasonal flu vaccine from 2030.

- In case of mobilizing aid and support from the country or the state budget, the Ministry of Health may decide to implement this roadmap sooner.

In addition, the Government also allows provinces and cities to have the ability to buy vaccines against cervical cancer if possible, at preferential prices for high-risk groups to encourage people to get vaccinated. sick.

NEW LEGAL DOCUMENT

7 LOSSES NOT COVERED BY INSURANCE IN CONSTRUCTION INVESTMENT

This is the content specified in Circular 50/2022/TT-BTC dated August 11, 2022 of the Ministry of Finance, regulating compulsory insurance in construction investment activities.

Specifically, Article 5 of this Circular stipulates: The insurance company is not liable for the following losses:

- Loss due to war, strike or rebellion according to regulations of State agencies.
- Damage caused by acts of terrorism.
- Loss due to nuclear radiation, nuclear reaction, radioactive contamination.
- Loss from their willful violation of the law by the policyholder or the insured.
- Loss in case the insurance buyer is not insured, according to Clause 9 Article 3 of the Law on Insurance Business.
- Loss due to cessation of construction work or loss resulting from cessation of construction work.
- Loss to data, software and computer programs.

This Circular takes effect from October 1, 2022.





TO RECEIVE A SUPPORT , A PRIVATE PRESCHOOL TEACHER AND A PRIVATE PRIMARY SCHOOL TEACHER MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS.

This is the content specified in Resolution 103/NQ-CP dated August 11, 2022. Including support policies for administrators, teachers, and employees in non-public preschool and primary education institutions who face difficulties due to the Covid-19 epidemic.

Accordingly, administrators, teachers and employees who work at private preschool and primary education institutions. They can be supported at 2.2 million VND/person or 3.7 million VND/person if the following conditions are met:

- Working at a private educational institution. Working before that educational institution suspends operations at the request of state agencies, in case the educational institution suspends operations for the prevention and control of the Covid-19 epidemic from May 1, 2021 to the end of December 31, 2021;
 - Having quit work without salary for 01 month or more, from May 1, 2021 to the end of December 31, 2021;
 - The support has not been received, in case: the employee suspends the labor contract, the employee takes leave without pay, the employee does not participate in compulsory social insurance according to Clauses 4, 5, 6 Section II Resolution No. 68/NQ-CP;
 - Have a certificate showing that you have worked at a private educational institution for at least the end of the school year 2021 - 2022.

ABOLISHING LEGAL DOCUMENTS ON METHODS FOR DETERMINING THE LOCALIZATION RATE FOR CARS

The Department of Science and Technology issued Circular No. 11/2022/TT-BKHCN abolishing legal documents issued about methods for determining the localization rate for cars. This Circular takes effect from October 1, 2022.

Specifically, Circular 11/2011/TT-BKHCN has abolished all 3 legal document as follows:

- Decision No.28/2004/QĐ-BKHCN dated October 1, 2004 of Minister of Science and Technology
- Decision No. 05/2005/QĐ-BKHCN dated May 11, 2005 of the Minister of Science and Technology on the amendment and supplementation of Decision No. 28/2004/QĐ-BKHCN dated October 1, 2004
- Circular No. 05/2012/TT-BKHCN dated 12/3/2012 of the Minister of Science and Technology

Currently, the documents regulating the method of determining the localization rate for automobiles are no longer suitable with the development practices of the automobile industry, because Vietnam still uses the calculation of the localization rate according to the cluster of parts produced in the country, meanwhile, ASEAN countries calculate according to the total value of each detail combined, to take tax incentives under the ASEAN Trade in Goods Agreement (ATIGA).
